Dear Parents,

It is official, St. Basil the Great School will be starting an after school CARES (Children Are Receiving Extended Service) Program starting on Monday, January 4.

The hours for the program will be from 3:00 pm to 6:00 pm and will be held in the Pre-K room. There are 5 day and 3 day options plus a drop in option should you need care for your child unexpectedly. The program will follow the same schedule as the school.

The program will be run by a Director. The 5 day option is \$300 per month and the 3 day option is \$180 per month. The drop in rate is \$25.00 a day. **All options require registration.**

If you are interested please fill in the attached registration form and send into school with a \$25.00 registration fee by **Friday, December 18**. Each child needs a form and a registration fee.

We are very excited to start this program and look forward to working with you to provide after school care for your children.
