Phoenixville Quickstart Tennis League



A Low-Cost Tennis Program Managed and Run by the Philadelphia Area Team Tennis Association

Learn and Play Tennis with the **Quickstart Tennis** format! Just as in baseball, soccer, and basketball, players will be placed on tennis teams and play against other teams. Here are some details:

Where: Fisher Park Tennis Courts

When: Matches and Practices will be Sunday afternoons and at one of 2 sessions (will vary each week) at either 1:00 or 2:30.

Cost: \$75 for the season, and includes uniform, award, and end of season party.

Ages: We'll have 8 and under and 10 and under divisions. To be in a division, a child must have turned that age by August 31st, 2009. Example: if a player turns 9 on September 21st, 2009, he or she qualifies for the 8 and under division. If a player turns 9 on July 21st, 2009, he or she will have to play in the 10 and under division.

Level of Play: The league is for beginner and intermediate players.

Team Coaches/Managers: Teams will be led by a tennis instructor for the practice portion. The instructor will oversee matches, but we highly encourage each team have a parent helper/volunteer that can help with tossing balls and scoring matches.

Play Format: We'll be using the Quickstart Format. The 8 and under division will be played on a 36 foot court with smaller racquet and foam balls. The 10 and under division will be played on a 60 foot court. For more information on format please visit www.phillyteamtennis.org
