Dear Parents,

This letter serves as a reminder of current immunization requirements.

Recently the Department of Health changed the immunization requirements for children attending Pennsylvania schools. The following immunizations are required by PA State Law for attendance in **all grades in 2011-2012**:

- 4 doses of tetanus and diphtheria (with one dose given on or after the fourth birthday)
- 3 doses of polio
- 2 doses of measles (given after 12 months)
- 2 dose of mumps (given after 12 months)
- 1 dose of rubella (given after 12 months)
- 3 doses of hepatitis B
- 2 doses of varicella (chickenpox) vaccine or history of the disease

Children attending 7th grade in 2011-2012 need the following:

- 1 dose of tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis (Tdap) if 5 years have elapsed since last tetanus immunization
- 1 dose of meningococcal conjugate vaccine (MCV)

All students (GradesK-12) must have immunization information on file in their school as a condition of attendance. Be sure your child's immunizations are in compliance with the current requirements.

Remember to keep the school nurse notified of any updated immunizations your child has received, so they can update their school records.

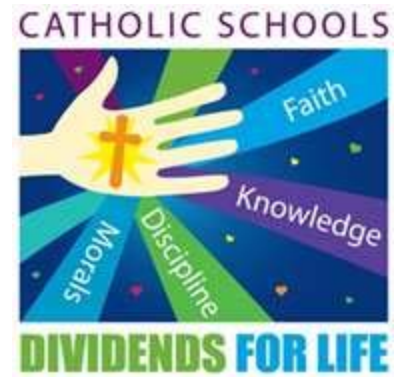

Souper Bowl Day- Bring in a can of soup for our local soup kitchen, and then you can wear a football jersey or the colors of your favorite super bowl team!

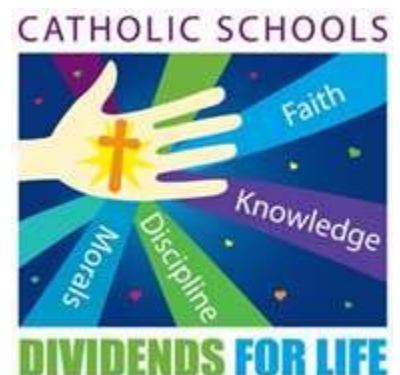
Square Dancing for the kids! We have an instructor coming to teach the kids square dancing - two grades at a time! Great Fun! Great Exercise!

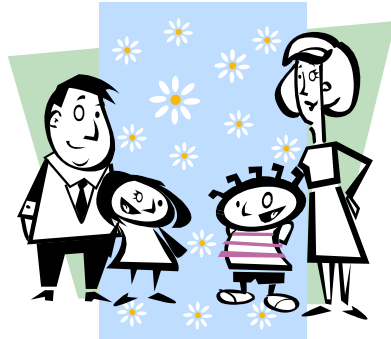
